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Quilt finishes 78" x 66"

*Big, bold triangles are the only shape needed to make this delightfully happy quilt. They are sewn together in vertical rows to create a movement that is both planned and whimsical at the same time. And speaking of time, with pieces this big the quilt is a great week-end sewing project for beginning and experienced quilters.*

## Fabric Requirements

|                            | Yardage  |

| Spring Dot Citrus          | 1¼ yard  |
| Spring Dot Fuchsia*        | 1½ yard  |
| Spring Dot Turquoise       | 1 yard   |
| Enchanted Damask Citrus    | ¾ yd     |
| Enchanted Damask Fuchsia   | 1 yard   |
| Enchanted Damask Turquoise | ¾ yd     |
| Backing                    |          |
| Enchanted Damask Fuchsia   | 5¾ yards |

\*Includes yardage for binding

## Cutting Directions

**Note:** WOF indicates cutting across the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge.

### Spring Dot Citrus

- Cut (2) 13¼" x WOF strips, cross cut into (5) 13¼" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice for 20 triangles.  
Cut (5) 3½" x WOF strips for borders

### Spring Dot Turquoise

- Cut (2) 13¼" x WOF strips, cross cut into (5) 13¼" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice for 20 triangles.  
Cut (2) 3½" x WOF strips for borders  
Cut (1) 3½" x 18½" strip from excess 13¼" strip for pieced border

### Spring Dot Fuchsia

- Cut (2) 13¼" x WOF strips, cross cut into (4) 13¼" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice for 16 triangles.  
Cut (1) 6⅞" x WOF strips, crosscut into (5) 6-7/8" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal once for (10) triangles  
Cut (1) 3½" x 12½" strip for pieced border strip  
Cut (8) 2½" x WOF strips for binding

### Enchanted Damask Citrus

- Cut (2) 13¼" x WOF strips, cross cut into (5) 13¼" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice for 20 triangles.

### Enchanted Damask Turquoise

- Cut (2) 13¼" x WOF strips, cross cut into (5) 13¼" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice for 20 triangles.

### Enchanted Damask Fuchsia

- Cut (2) 13¼" x WOF strips, cross cut into (4) 13¼" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice for 16 triangles.  
Cut (1) 6⅞" x WOF strips, crosscut into (5) 6⅞" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal once for (10) triangles

**Backing:** Cut and sew the backing fabric to measure 82" x 70"

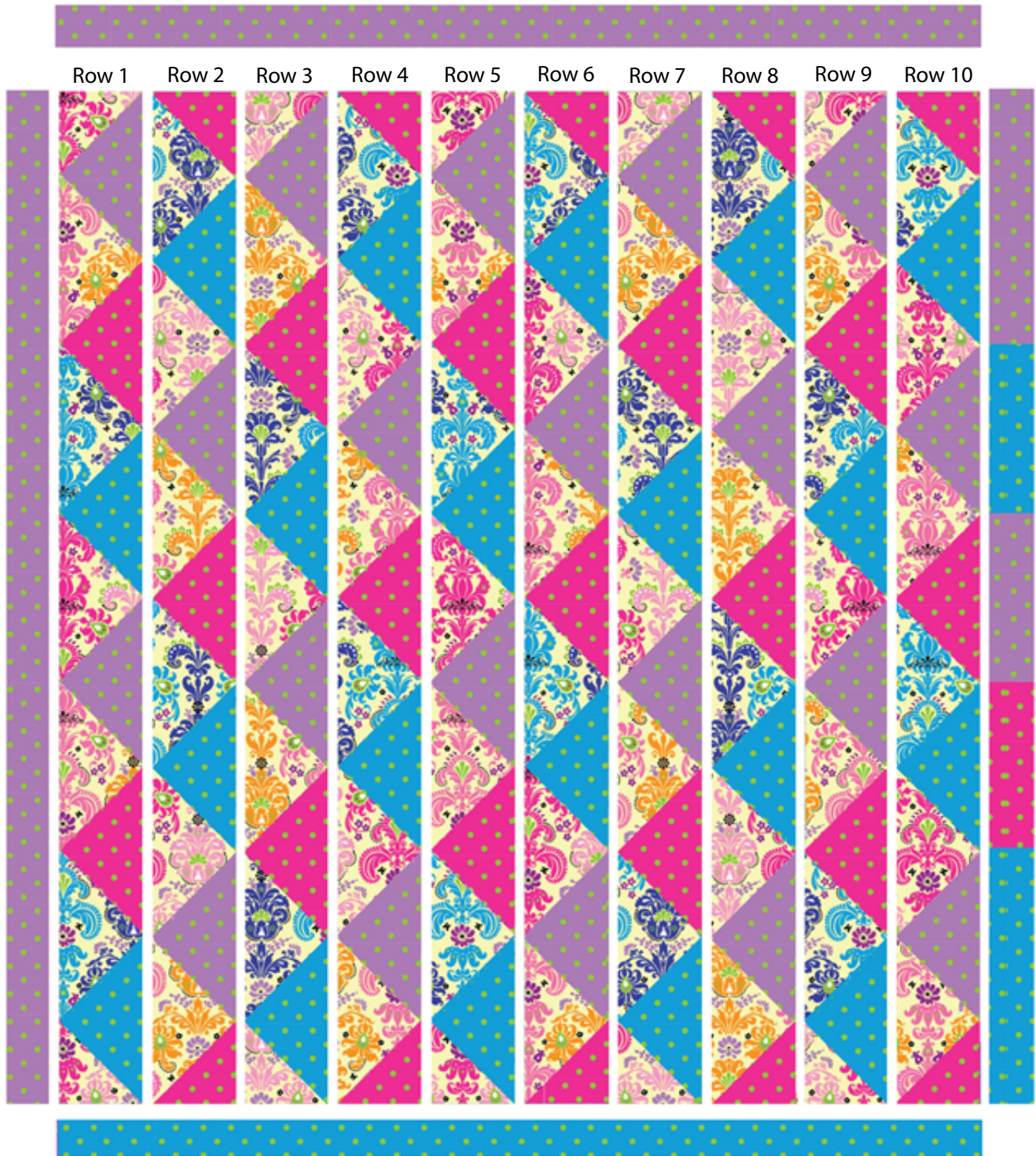
## Making The Quilt

1. Refer to the Quilt Diagram of the quilt throughout quilt assembly for placement of the prints and colors of the triangles.
2. Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 are identical and Rows, 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 are identical. Begin and end all of the strips with small triangles. Arrange the large triangles as shown and sew them into vertical strips. Press seams taking care not to stretch bias edges of triangles.
3. Sew the vertical rows together in numerical order. Match the triangle points and pin in place before starting to sew each row.
4. Sew the citrus border strips together end-to-end. Cut (1) border strip 72½" long and sew to the left side of the quilt. Cut a top border strip 66½" long and set aside. Cut remainder into (1) piece 18½" long and (1) piece 12½" long.
5. Sew the turquoise border strips together end-to-end. Cut the bottom border 66½" long and set aside. Cut the remainder of the strip into (1) piece 12½" long for pieced border; set aside.
6. Refer to the Quilt Diagram and sew the pieced border together as shown. Sew pieced the border to the left side of the quilt top.
7. Sew the citrus border to the top of the quilt and the turquoise border to the bottom of the quilt top.

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### Finishing

8. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch along the vertical seams, then along the diagonal seams. Add free-motion quilting in the triangles if desired. Bind with Spring Dots Fuchsia to finish the quilt.
