Fabric Requirements

	Yardage
Spring Dot Citrus	¾ yard
Spring Dot Fuchsia*	1½ yard
Spring Dot Turquoise	1½ yd
Enchanted Damask Citrus	½ yd
Enchanted Damask Fuchsia	7⁄8 yard
Enchanted Damask Turquoise	½ yd
Backing	
Enchanted Damask Fuchsia	4½ yards

*Includes yardage for binding

Cutting Directions

Note: WOF indicates cutting across the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge.

Spring Dot Citrus

Cut (2) 6⁷/₈" x WOF strips, crosscut into (12) 6⁷/₈" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make 24 triangles

Cut (7) 1½" x WOF strips for inside borders

Spring Dot Turquoise

Cut (2) 6⁷/₈" x wof strips, crosscut into (12) 6⁷/₈" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make 24 triangles

Cut (7) 3½" x WOF strips for outside borders

Spring Dot Fuchsia

Cut (4) 6⁷/₈" x WOF strips, crosscut into (24) 6⁷/₈" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make 48 triangles

Cut (8) 2½" x WOF strips for binding

Enchanted Damask Citrus

Cut (2) 6⁷/₈" x WOF strips, crosscut into (12) 6⁷/₈" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make 24 triangles

Enchanted Damask Turquoise

Cut (2) 6⁷/₈" x WOF strips, crosscut into (12) 6⁷/₈" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make 24 triangles

Enchanted Damask Fuchsia

Cut (4) 6⁷/₈" x WOF strips, crosscut into (24) 6⁷/₈" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make 48 triangles

Backing: Cut and sew the backing fabric to measure 80" x 63"

Pinwheel blocks are a favorite for quilters. There are so many ways they can be arranged to make an exciting quilt design. Here they are simply sewn together block to block as they let the vibrant colors create pattern and movement.

Making The Quilt

1. Refer to the Quilt Diagram of the quilt throughout quilt assembly for placement of the prints and colors of the triangle units.

2. Sew the (48) fuchsia sprint dots triangles to the (48) fuchsia enchanted damask triangles.



3. Sew the (24) spring dots citrus triangles to the (24) enchanted damask turquoise triangles. Sew the (24) spring dots turquoise triangles to the (24) enchanted damask citrus triangles. Sew the triangle units together in sets of (4) to make (6) Pinwheel blocks in each color combination.



4. Sew the triangle units made in Step 2 to each side of the 12 completed Pinwheel blocks.



5. Alternate the spring dots turquoise blocks with the spring dots citrus blocks to sew (4) rows of blocks with (3) blocks in each row. Sew the rows together.

6. Sew the spring dots citrus border strips together end-to-end. Cut (2) vertical borders 68½" long and sew to sides of quilt. Cut (2) horizontal borders 53½" long and sew to top and bottom of the quilt top.

7. Sew the spring dots turquoise border strips together end-to-end. Cut (2) vertical borders 70½" long and sew to sides of quilt. Cut (2) horizontal borders 59½" long and sew to top and bottom of the quilt top.

Finishing

- 8. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch along the vertical seams, then along the diagonal seams. Add free-motion quilting in the triangles if desired. Bind with Spring Dots Fuchsia to finish the quilt.
